Dear Minister,

I have the honor to express our willingness to register ACTS World Relief and, to operate on a more regular basis within the Rules and Laws of the Republic of Haiti. ACTS is a NGO registered in the United States of America on the following number (see copy of registration certificate, appendix 1).

I have to inform you that ACTS has been working in Haiti since January 16th in helping those in dire needs resulting from the earthquake. We have set up an important network of volunteers and trained youths to serve the Haitian population. We are planning to offer a more targeted and holistic support to some specific groups in Haiti.

ACTS has been requested by CTMO- HOPE Commission, an Official Agency of the Government of Haiti (GoH) to inspect Haitian industrial textile and some Government buildings with our engineers and architects. We have provided this assistance at NO CHARGE to CTMO- HOPE Commission, as well as medical and mental health training and service. Such cooperative endeavors will continue as ACTS World Relief continues to mobilize as CTMO-HOPE may express such cooperative needs (Cooperative Agreement signed with the CTMO-HOPE, appendix 2; and a synopsis of the work accomplished after the earthquake, appendix 3)

However, it becomes now critical for ACTS World Relief to have a formal and regular status to be able to continue to serve legally in Haiti. Because the mid and long term endeavors that we are called to contribute at require your unique special authorization, so that our equipments, tools, Experts, skilled personnel... could be admit into Haiti. We submit to you in appendix 4 our Phase III related to rehabilitation of youth amputees, educational (Train-the-Trainer), feeding hot lunch, food distribution and Mental health.

I am waiting for your guidance on what our Organization should do as next steps in its formalization process.
